- Must be currently enrolled as an undergraduate at Atlantic Cape Community College and have earned 12 credits at the time of application.
- Must maintain a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours per semester

Part Time/Non Traditional Student

- Must be enrolled in RSU, FDU, or ACCC
- Must have earned 6 credits at the time of application
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of 3 credits per semester.
